CRITERIA

Winner will be determined on the basis of a 750-1000 word essay on:

The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of Aboriginal Canadians.

An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

ELIGIBILITY

All Aboriginal Canadian children (including foster children) of National Union of Public and General Employees members who plan to enter the first year of a Canadian public post-secondary education institution full-time in 2007-2008 are eligible to apply.

AWARD

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500
