

## The National Union's scholarship program for 2017



The National Union of Public and General Employees (NUPGE) offers four scholarships of \$1,500 each that reflect its pursuit of equal opportunity for all workers. They are open to the children and grandchildren of the National Union's 370,000 members who are starting a post-secondary education. All scholarships are available to students who plan to enter the first year of a Canadian public, post-secondary, educational institution full-time in 2017 - 2018 and who are the children / grandchildren or foster children / grandchildren of a current or retired NUPGE member. Outlined below is the extra criteria required for each of these scholarships.

In addition to above, The Brian Fudge Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to an eligible student for the best 750 - 1,000 word essay on: The importance of their field of study in either policing, criminal justice services or health care in delivering public services to Canadians.

In addition to above, The Tommy Douglas Scholarship will be awarded to an eligible student for the best 750 - 1,000 word essay on: How Tommy Douglas contributed to making Canada a more just and equitable society.

In addition to above, The Terry Fox Memorial Scholarship is open to eligible students with disabilities and will be awarded for the best 750 - 1,000 word essay on: The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of people with disabilities.

In addition to above, The Scholarship for Aboriginal Canadians is open to eligible students who are Aboriginal Canadian and will be awarded for the best 750 - 1,000 word essay on: The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of Aboriginal Canadians.

In addition to above, The Scholarship for Visible Minorities is open to eligible students who are a visible minority and will be awarded for the best 750 - 1,000 word essay on: The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of visible minorities.

The deadline for all scholarships is July 7, 2017.
